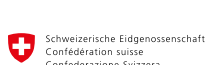

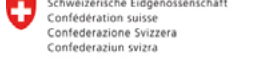

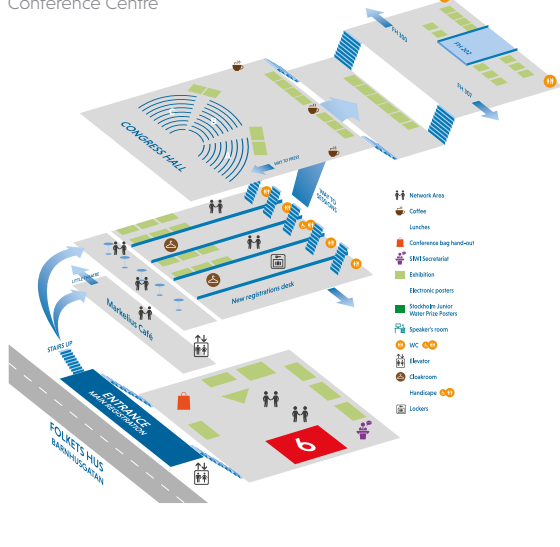

The International ReSource Award - Entrepreneurial Solutions for Resilience in Water Management

The International ReSource Award for resilience in water management is a prize acknowledging social entrepreneurial thinking and leadership in implementing the principles of sustainability in water management. It recognizes new approaches for resolving existing issues related to sustainable water management. Every year, an international jury awards USD 150 000 to new social entrepreneurial initiatives driving sustainable water management practices.

Solidarit'eau Suisse - Swiss Municipalities and Water Utilities Helping to Provide Clean Drinking Water to People in Developing Countries

Solidarit'eau Suisse is a platform that connects Swiss municipalities and water utilities with Swiss development organizations that implement water projects in developing countries. With the financial support of a municipality or water utility, water projects can be realized. Solidarit'eau Suisse promotes not only individual projects but also the development of long-term partnerships with a municipality/water supply in a developing country (Public-Public Partnerships).

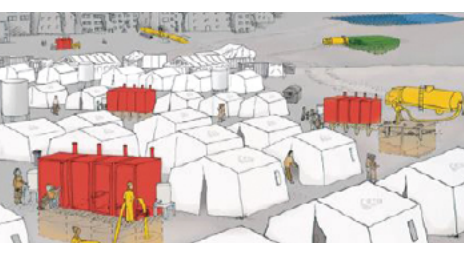
Swiss Junior Water Prize 2018 - Engaging Youth in the Water Sector

The «Swiss Junior Water Prize 2018» was awarded to Laura Bauer from Rapperswil-Jona for her research work «Littorella uniflora on the upper shore of Lake Zürich – Human impact on the ecology and distribution of an endangered species». Laura Bauer performed an excellent scientific research focused on a water whose population in Switzerland and in many other European countries has been drastically reduced due to human activities, a subject particularly relevant under this year's World Water Week main topic.
